- The Washoe County Health District (WCHD) parks directory has been a useful resource for the community, bringing attention and awareness of the various open space and parks available for residents.
- Carson City Health and Human Services (CCHHS) Due to COVID-19 limitations, CCHHS discovered ways to improve communication capabilities during the accreditation process
- Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) provided Diabetes Self-Management Education (DSME) and Support Classes to underserved communities in Southern Nevada. COVID-19 limitations allowed SNHD to be more agile in providing the classes.
