



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
Behavioral Health Data – State Facilities

Southern Nevada Region Counties Most Common Primary Diagnosis, 2010-2016.






Southern Nevada Region Counties Emergency Room Visits for Select Mental Health Disorders by Quarter, 2009-2016.


Southern Nevada Region Counties Inpatient Admissions for Select Mental Health Disorders by Quarters, 2009-2016.

Southern Nevada Region Counties Emergency Room Visits for Alcohol- and Substance-Related Diagnoses by Quarter, 2009-2016.





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

Southern Nevada Region Counties Health and Substance-Related Deaths, 2009-2016.







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

Southern Nevada Region Counties Opioid-Related Deaths, 2009-2016.




