 - SB 44: Rural Regional Behavioral Health Policy Board's Bill, focused on improving paths to Nevada licensure for behavioral health professionals.
 - SB 116: AN ACT relating to mental health; providing for the establishment of a program to provide training concerning the identification of persons who have certain behavioral health conditions; providing for the reporting of information relating to distance education and the effects of distance education non the mental health of pupils and teachers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
 - SB146: AN ACT relating to mental health; requiring certain psychiatric facilities to consult with the treating psychiatrist of a child with an emotional disturbance who is living outside his or her home under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
 - AB180: AN ACT relating to insurance; requiring the adoption of regulations to require insurers offering policies of insurance which provide for the payment of expenses which are not covered by Medicare to offer at least one such policy to provide coverage to certain persons with a disability; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
 - AB181: AN ACT relating to mental health; providing for the reporting of certain information by certain health-related facilities relating to suicide; requiring certain insurers and other organizations providing health coverage to adhere to certain provisions of federal law; requiring certain insurers and other organizations providing health coverage to submit a report demonstrating mental health parity and addiction equity compliance; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
 - SB154: AN ACT relating to Medicaid; requiring the Department of Health and Human Services to apply for a waiver to receive federal funding for coverage of the treatment of the substance use disorder of a person in an institution for mental diseases; authorizing the Department to apply for a waiver to receive federal funding for coverage of the treatment of certain mental health conditions of persons in an diseases; and providing other matters properly relating thereto



- SB156: AN ACT relating to mental health; revising certain requirements for an endorsement as a crisis stabilization center; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
- AB346: AN ACT relating to health care; establishing procedures for fixing the rates charged by hospitals, independent centers for emergency medical care, surgical centers for ambulatory patients and physicians for certain goods and services; authorizing the imposition of a civil penalty and initiation of disciplinary action against such a facility or a physician who fails to comply with provisions concerning rate fixing; creating certain causes of action to enforce those provisions; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
- AB374: AN ACT relating to substance use disorders; creating the Substance Use Disorder Working Group and the Opioid Abatement Fund; requiring the Working Group to allocate the proceeds of certain litigation between the Fund and certain local governments; requiring the Working Group to award grants and financial support from the Fund to support programs, procedures and strategies of certain state and local governmental entities for treating, preventing or reducing opioid use disorder and the misuse of opioids; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
- SB 390: AN ACT relating to mental health; providing for the establishment of a suicide prevention and mental health crisis hotline; requiring the imposition of a surcharge on certain communications services to support the hotline; creating the Capital Fund for Behavioral Health; requiring the State Treasurer to deposit the proceeds of certain litigation into the Fund; requiring the Department of Health and Human Services to award grants from the Fund to support certain capital projects; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
