





Q3 Are you a member of the LGTBQ+ community?





Q5 What is your race? Please check all that apply.




Q6 What is your ethnicity?


Q7 If you or someone you care about was feeling a lot of stress, anxiety, depression, or experiencing a crisis or tragedy, would you know where to go for help?








