

# NORD's Rare Disease Advisory Council Work

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## **The Problem**

- **25-30 million Americans** are living with one of the more than 7,000 unique rare diseases.
- Even though estimated **1 in 10 Americans** have a rare disease, state decision makers often have limited awareness and knowledge of the impact that rare diseases can have on patients, their caregivers, and the overall health care system.









# The Solution – Rare Disease Advisory Councils

- Create a diverse body that represents the rare disease community to advise state government on common obstacles
- Enormous opportunity for government officials and the rare disease community to partner together to develop resources necessary to prevent and address barriers in a strategic way
