## **Undetectable = Untransmittable (U = U) Reduce the Risk.**



U = U a.k.a virally suppressed. When persons living with HIV are on effective medically proven treatment it reduces the amount of HIV (viral load) in the blood. Persons can eventually over time have an undetectable viral load or virally suppressed. Persons living with HIV who are virally suppressed cannot pass HIV through sexual contact, sharing needles, or breastfeeding.
