- 3. For Possible Action: Review and approval of meeting minutes Stephan Page

Caesar Espinoza motioned for a review and approval of July 21, 2022. Cheryl Radeloff gave second motion for a review and approval of July 21, 2022.

Discussion about the flyers and marketing materials from Nevada Legal Services. The flyers were well received from members of the board. Kwame is open to feedback. Members gave language/wording recommendations and suggestions for the legality of withholding HIV status to partners, Undetectable/Un-transmittable, sex work, and law enforcement. Kwame will incorporate feedback and suggestions from HIV Task Force Advisory members. Further discussion surrounding changing the term to HIV Modernization language to appeal to the public and concern for sexual health.

6. **For Possible Action:** Discussion and Possible Action to engage Nevada Legal Services for assistance with Task Force research and outreach
