SB297	Revises provisions relating to agriculture.	Requires the Council on Food Security to research and develop recommendations on community gardens and urban farms.	No upcoming hearings scheduled as of March 31, 2021.
SB25	Revises provisions governing the determination of whether food for human consumption is subject to sales and use taxes.	May impact Nevada food insecurity.	Introduced: November 18, 2020 March 23, 2021: In Assembly. Read first time. Referred to Committee on Revenue. To committee. No upcoming hearings scheduled as of March 31, 2021.
SB124	Revises provisions governing the eligibility of certain convicted persons for public assistance.	Impacts certain individuals' eligibility for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits/access to food.	Introduced: February 17, 2021 No upcoming hearings scheduled as of March 31, 2021.
