1 Data are insufficient to precisely define the duration of time that constitutes a prolonged exposure. Until more is known about transmission risks, it is reasonable to consider an exposure of 15 minutes or more as prolonged. However, any duration should be considered prolonged if the exposure occurred during performance of an aerosol generating procedure. Data are limited for the definition of close contact. For this guidance it is defined as: a) being within 6 feet of a person with confirmed COVID-19 or b) having unprotected direct contact with infectious secretions or excretions of the person with confirmed COVID-19. Determining the time period when the patient, visitor, or HCP with confirmed COVID-19 could have been infectious: 1.For individuals with confirmed COVID-19 who developed symptoms, consider the exposure window to be 2 days before symptom onset through the time period when the individual meets criteria for discontinuation of Transmission-Based Precautions.

#### **Additional Notes:**

1. While the DHHS Technical Bulletin, *Guidance for Public Health Management of Healthcare Personnel(HCP) with Potential Exposure to Patients with (COVID-19) in Healthcare Setting* based on CDC guidance allows exposed, asymptomatic HCPs to work while utilizing appropriate PPE. This guidance **does not apply** to HCP's in the dental arena.

2. The <u>CDC recommends</u> implementing sick leave policies for dental health care personnel that are flexible, non-punitive, and consistent with public health guidance.
