Per NRS 233B.105(2), upon adoption of any regulations, the agency, if requested to do so by a small business, either prior to adoption or within 90 days thereafter, shall issue a petition based on the following grounds:

- The agency failed to prepare a small business impact statement as required pursuant to NRS 233B.0608 and 233B.0609; or
- (b) The small business impact statement prepared by the agency pursuant to NRS 233B.0608 and 233B.0609 is inaccurate, incomplete or did not adequately consider or significantly underestimated the economic effect of the regulation on small businesses.

Per NRS 233B.064(2), upon adoption of any regulations, the agency, if requested to do so by an interested person, either prior to adoption or within 30 days thereafter, shall issue a concise statement of the principle reasons for and against its adoption, and incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.
