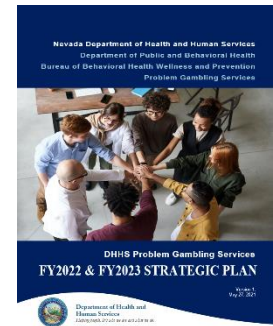

Treatment Enhancement Options:



Enhancement Areas

1. Increase Add-on codes percentage
2. Expand level of care cap reset to include stepping between intensive (9+ hrs/wk) and non-intensive outpatient treatment.

OR

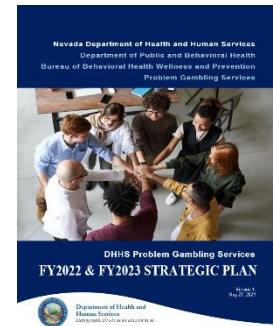
3. Increase the booster session cap
4. Expand workforce development encounter codes
5. Bristlecone expansion

Comments

1. Currently at 10%. Increases treatment provider flexibility to spend down granted funds.
2. The current outpatient and residential caps –
 - Outpatient - \$3,000
 - Residential -\$4000 .
3. Currently set at \$500. Increase to \$1,000?
4. Currently add-on funds can be used as reimbursement for cost of training and travel. Could expand to include reimbursement for counselor time and/or expanded supervision coverage.
5. Requesting additional \$132,000; Department projected claims suggest \$40,500 increase.

To reduce risk of under-funding, could keep money in reserves for later re-allocation

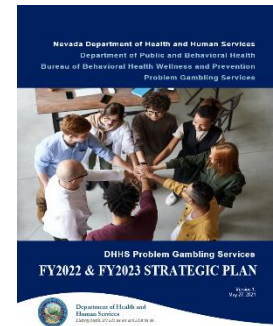
Enhancement Areas

1. Public awareness campaign enhancement
2. Gambling Treatment Diversion Court enhancement
3. Research enhancement to fund an additional project

Comments

1. Currently budgeted \$100K; Flexible program enhancements – work to be determined based on budget allocation
2. Currently budgeted \$50K; \$6,180 requested in additional funds to be used for financial coaching and Moral Recognition Therapy (MRT) support to current participants..
3. Currently budgeted \$200K; \$100k in additional funds to fund an additional project to complete a gambling and problem gambling survey.

Enhancement Areas

4. Prevention contract enhancement
5. Workforce development enhancements
6. Workforce incentive program

Comments

4. Currently budgeted \$187,500K; Requesting additional \$8,208 to support expansion of the Open Public Information Session.
5. Currently budgeted \$42K; 10K in additional funds to add modules to the Peer Training Course specifically for a Problem Gambling Peer Endorsement.
6. Currently not funded; \$6,480 requested to develop and fund incentive program to increase the number of CPGCs.
