

Safe Sleep and Diaper Resource Committee Request for Application Questions

1. It states that we do have to submit the signed application, but we did not see a space for a signature. Can you please confirm where you would like to see this, or if there's a page we are missing?

A: Please add a signature to the last page of the application.

2. Under Part A and B's description sections it states the services must be statewide. Is this preferred, or are we able to choose the regions served? If it were specifically to serve a region, is there a budget amount based on the needs of Northern and Southern Nevada?

A: For part A: Services should be provided statewide, however, if you are only able to serve specific regions, please outline the regions. Please indicate if you absolutely cannot provide services statewide, or if this is just a preference. For Part B: The Diapering Resource Committee is required to be statewide. The ceiling for Safe Sleep is \$110,000 and for Diaper Resource Committee is \$65,000.

3. Are you able to provide any guidelines on the expectation of persons served or partner assistance?

A: For Part A: Cribs for Kids provides Safe Sleep Kits to those who otherwise would not have a safe sleep environment for their baby. For Part B: Please reference [NRS 422A.670](#).

4. Can a for profit agency apply?

A: Yes, you may apply. Just document this under "Organization Type" on the application form. If you are a State MSA vendor, you may apply and contract through a Service Agreement.

5. Have any IHS clinics, federal not tribal been able to apply for a receive this grant?

A: We cannot disclose who has applied for the funds.

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6. On the Budget narrative form, I will not be using the grant to cover salary, travel, any lease costs, or office supplies. I just need to order car seats and cribs, but I don't see a field to fill in the estimate for those. What category should these be placed in?

A: You can place the car seats and cribs under Other or Operating. Whichever category your agency prefers.

7. How does the Diaper Resources Committee program work? Will I be able to order diapers for my clients? And if so, does that mean I will have to store diapers to have available for clients, like with car seats and cribs? The description of the DRC looks like I would be applying to be on a resource committee but doesn't explain how I would get diapers for my clients.

A: The Diaper Resources Committee is an open meeting law committee. This RFA is to seek a partner to run and operate the committee as support staff. This would entail supporting scheduling, completing meeting minutes, completing required reports, completing appointment packets, and sending appointment letters, apply for grants on behalf of the committee, etc. This RFA is not intended to apply for diapers.

8. For Section II, Question 3, Part 1, the RFA states: *Describe the goals and objectives to meet the geographic area's safe sleep and other specified service needs.* If we are only applying for the Diapering Resources Committee, do we still need to answer this question? If so, would we just describe the specified service needs in relation to diapering resources in the state?

A: No, you do not need to answer question three for the Diapering Resource Committee portion of the grant. You could, however, say that the committee serves statewide.

9. Do you anticipate any travel being needed to support the Diapering Resources Committee? It looked like all of the public meetings have been conducted remotely for the past few years.

A: No, there will be no travel required for Diapering Resources Committee. All the meetings are virtual.
