## Informational Notice: Secretary of State Business License:

Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 76 (NRS 76) sections 76.100 and 76.105 require all persons who conduct business in Nevada to obtain a business license or a certificate of exemption from the Secretary of State (SOS). The state business license and certificate of exemption are required in addition to any applicable county, city, or other local business licenses.

Effective September 30, 2023, the Radiation Control Program will require all radioactive material licensees, radiation producing machine registrants (including mammography) and service providers for radiation producing machines to upload their state business license or a certificate of exemption into the Radiation Control Program Online Licensing System. All licensees, registrants and service providers are encouraged to upload their state business license before September 1, 2023. Below are applicable sections of NRS 76.100 and 76.105.

NRS 76.100 State business license required: application and fee for license; activities constituting conduct of business.

- 1. A person shall not conduct business in the State unless and until the person obtains a state business license issued by the Secretary of State. If the person is:
  - a. An entity required to file an initial or annual list with the Secretary of State pursuant to the title, the person must obtain the state business license at the time of filing the initial or annual list.
  - b. Not an entity required to file an initial or annual list with the Secretary of State pursuant to the title, the person must obtain the state business license before conducting business in this State.

NRS 76.105 Claim for exemption; renewal; exceptions.

Except as otherwise provided in subsection 6, a person who claims to be excluded from the
requirement to obtain a state business license because the person is an entity, organization,
person or business listed in subsection 2 of NRS 76.020 or who conducts a business in this State
but claims to be exempt from the requirement to obtain a state business license must submit
annually to the Secretary of State an application for a certificate of exemption on a form provided
by the Secretary of State.
