

Opioid Overdose Community Preparedness Planning: Q&A

Question and Answers

- ▶ Q. Can you please clarify the funding for the project? On page 5 of the funding announcement, it states that the first half of funds are released October 2018 and the second half of funds are released February/March 2019. Then on page 41, it states that RFRs are due the 15th of the month.
 - ▶ A. We are working on a process to provide advanced funding for the project. Funds will be released upon receipt of the RFRs.
- ▶ Q. Please clarify - On the original funding announcement, a budget plan was not required, then on the 2nd proposal a budget plan is required.
 - ▶ A. The second proposal included an expansion on the organizations that could oversee the funding allocation. Due to this change, a budget plan is required due to entry into more subawards and those sub awardees will need to be aware of how to draw down funds.
- ▶ Q. Who do you expect to be a leadership organization for this program?
 - ▶ It was written as a community coalition, health department, or local EMS. Other organizations may also act as the leadership organization if they can gain support from the needed stakeholders and also provide a letter of endorsement from the health department and local EMS.
- ▶ Will there be funding for implementation?
 - ▶ The first half of the funding is intended for the initial plan development. The second half of the funding is intended for implementation.
