Topic: Sealed Source Reporting to the Radiation Control Program (RCP)

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To: Medical and Radiopharmacy Licensees

Date: August 2, 2012

Licensees with authorization to possess any sealed source permitted by NAC 459.3062 (10 CFR 35.65) will have a license condition added to the license to help document and report the number and activity of sealed sources in possession and maintain control of sealed sources. The condition reads:

The licensee shall submit a complete written inventory to the Radiation Control Program (RCP) for any change in the number of sealed sources or an increase in activity of the sealed sources permitted by 10 CFR 35.65. The inventory shall list the manufacturer, model and serial number, nuclide, activity, purpose of use, and storage location.

Licensees that provide extended services to customers, including supplying sealed sources of any type, will have a license condition added to the license that details the reporting requirements for transferring sealed sources and maintaining control of sealed sources. The condition reads:

When removing sealed sources from a licensee location that will no longer be used for licensed activities, document a physical inventory of all sealed sources on hand describing the manufacturer, model number, serial number radionuclide, and activity. Document which sources were removed by this licensee and;

- A. Submit copies of the records described in this condition to the Radiation Safety Officer or the office manager; or
- B. Submit copies of the records described in this condition to the Nevada Radiation Control Program (RCP) within 30 days of sealed source(s) removal.
